

Privacy statute of the association CONELIS e.V.

(Version 1 – 25 May 2018)

Preamble

The association CONELIS e.V. collects and processes personal data from its members. According to Art. 13 GDPR, this privacy statute serves to inform the members and those interested in the association about their rights as concerned persons.

1. Responsibility

2. Privacy Officer

CONELIS e.V. is not obliged to appoint a privacy officer. The contact person for all questions regarding the protection of personal data is the association's board.

3. Purpose of data processing and legal basis

The following personal data is processed for the membership of CONELIS e.V.:

Name, address, contact details, job title, bank details and the names of the two members who acted as referee for accession.

These details are mandatory for the implementation of the membership. If the information is incomplete or incorrect, the membership application cannot be processed.

As part of association's events, name and address and contact details, as well as possibly further event-specific information is collected and processed during registration. Depending on the specific event, the legal basis is either Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b GDPR or the legitimate interest of the association in meaningful and cost-saving event planning (Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f GDPR)

4. Presentation of the members on the homepage

On request, the members of CONELIS e.V. have the opportunity to introduce themselves on the homepage of the association for the purpose of public relations with their professional profile. The member concerned decides which personal data should be published. Data processing takes place on the basis of the voluntary consent of the data subject (Article 6 (1) sentence 1 (a) GDPR). This consent can be withdrawn at any time with effect for the future. The revocation must be addressed to the association board. The contact details can be found in section 1 of the privacy statute.

5. Recipient of personal data

The board members and volunteers of CONELIS e.V. have access to the member data.

The association uses contract processors for the administration of the association and the external presentation, with whom a contract processing contract has been concluded and whose proper handling of the data is regularly checked.

In addition, in accordance with the requirements of SEPA, the member's name and bank details are transferred to the bank holding the account in order to collect the membership fees.

6. Third Country

There is no transfer of personal data to countries outside the EU / EEA.

7. Duration of storage

Membership data will be stored for three years after expiry of the membership, provided that no further retention requirements exist. Data collected in connection with events will be deleted after expiry of the commercial and tax retention periods.

8. Right to Information, Correction, Deletion, Restriction, Data Portability

At CONELIS e.V. you can always obtain information about the personal data stored about you at the association. Please contact the board for this. Here also changes / corrections of the personal data can be communicated.

Restriction or deletion of the data is possible in principle, but not in the case of data forming the basis for membership.

Upon request, we also provide your personal data in a machine-readable format (data portability).

9. Right of appeal to the supervisory authority

If you have any questions or want to complain about the handling of your personal data, please contact the Board of CONELIS e.V.

In addition, you have the right to complain about the processing of your data by the Data Protection Inspectorate. You can do this at the competent authority of your domicile or at the supervisory authority responsible for CONELIS e.V.
