

Dues Schedule of CONELIS e.V.

§ 1 Basis

- (1) The basis for the provisions of this dues schedule are the articles of the association CONELIS e.V. in their version of 12 October 2018, in particular their § 6.
- (2) The General Assembly has adopted the below dues schedule during its sessions on 23 March 2018 and 12 October 2018.

§ 2 Rates of the minimal membership fees

- (1) The rate of the minimal membership fee is based on the type of membership.
- (2) For natural persons as full members or sustaining members, the minimal membership fees are 300 EUR per business year.
- (3) For legal persons as sustaining members the below listed fees based on the numbers of employees will be applied per business year

1 – 10 employees:	300 Euro
11 – 50 employees:	500 Euro
51 – 400 employees:	1,000 Euro
from 401 employees:	2,000 Euro

- (4) For members joining on or before 30 June of a respective calendar year, the minimal membership fees are payable in full for the current business year, independently from the date of admission. For members joining after 30 June of a respective calendar year, half of the minimal membership fees are payable for the current business year, independently from the date of admission.
- (5) A one-time admission fee of 300 EUR will be due at the date of admission to the association for full members and sustaining members.

§ 3 Due date and payment period for the minimum membership fee

- (1) The minimum membership fees are due at the beginning of each business year or at the date of admission to the association.
- (2) The minimum membership fees are payable within the first calendar month or within one calendar month following the date of admission to the association.

§ 4 Payment modalities

- (1) All fees are payable to the account of the association. Bank details will be announced to the members, as it is customary.
- (2) Should the association establish a respective agreement with its bank, members maintaining banking accounts in the Single Euro Payments Area (SEPA) might be given the opportunity to pay the minimum membership fee through SEPA direct debit by granting direct-debit authorization to the association. The member may revoke the authorization at any time. Provisions as customary in banking will be applied.

§ 5 Administrative fees, arrears fees, and fees for late payment

- (1) There will be no administrative fees.
- (2) Arrears fees are 20 EUR per reminder. The first reminder can be issued on the very first day after the statutory payment period has been passing; the second reminder one month later.
- (3) There will be no fees for late payment.
- (4) Should debiting of the membership fees for a granted direct-debit authorization fail, the member will bear any resulting additional cost if the failure was due to insufficient funds on the member's account or due to incorrect bank details as provided by the member.

§ 6 Announcement and coming into effect

- (1) The dues schedule will be announced to all members of the association as it is customary and will come into effect as of 1 January 2019.
- (2) Members who join the association after such a date will have opportunity for perusal of the dues schedule. It will be binding for them after admission as well.
